

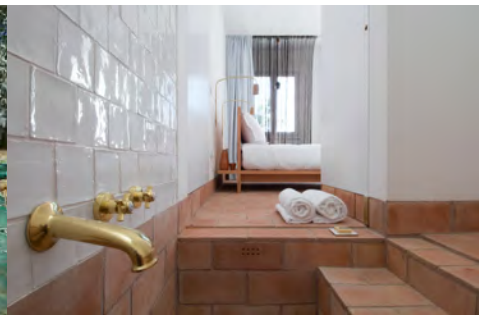
Portugal 5 Nights for Two

PLACE

From Casa Modesta you witness the migration of birds, the practice of shellfish gathering or the harvesting of salt, and everyday we are astonished by the small miracles that nature performs.

Casa Modesta located in Olhão, just 60 km from Spain, was born, combining rural tourism with a contemporary feel, manifested in nine rooms with private patios, and freshwater chemical free pool. There is also a garden with a section for organically grown vegetables and a solarium where time flows with the tides.

ACTIVITIES

Includes one the following activites each day: biking and bird watching in the adjacent wetlands of Ria Formasa National Park, olive oil tour and tasting from international award winning Monterosa Olive Oils , Portuguese cooking demonstration, ceramic studio tour, and nature walking tour in Ria Formosa National Park.

A paradise for birdwatchers, the Ria Formosa is considered an important bird area and is part of the Natura 2000 Network. This is one of the most important areas for aquatic birds in Portugal, hosting on a regular basis more than 20,000 birds during the wintering period. The area is also very important as stop-over point in the migration routes between Europe and Africa and it provides shelter for rare species in Portugal.
