WHAT: Moonlight in the Garden at JC Raulston Arboretum returns this November for seven nights. Magical lighting display, live music, food trucks, marshmallows and fire pits—they're all back. The Arboretum will open its gates for a limited time in November for a beautiful evening stroll. This magical display of light is custom designed and installed by John Garner and his team at Southern Lights of Raleigh and a dedicated group of Arboretum volunteers.

This isn't a typical lighting event. "Moonlight in the Garden is a time to bundle up, welcome the fall season, revel in the exhibition where garden design meets lighting artistry, dine at the best food trucks, enjoy the live music, sip on hot apple cider, and roast marshmallows over the fire pits." said Mark Weathington, Director of JC

Raulston Arboretum. "Moonlight in the Garden is a chance for us to light up the garden and share what a magical place the Arboretum can be at night."

Moonlight in the Garden is meticulously designed to showcase the JC Raulston Arboretum's internationally acclaimed garden in all its splendor. The collection is spectacular by day, but takes on a new life under the cover of darkness artfully lit on a crisp November evening. It is a magical experience not to be missed.

New to the *Moonlight* exhibition this year is "Post Modern Patterns." Thirty talented artists and students from 9 elementary schools give their modern take on the fanciful Mexican folk-art form of *Alebrijes*. The lighting adds another dimension to the already colorful creations of this ephemeral art exhibit.

Moonlight in the Garden will inspire every homeowner with ways to extend their outdoor living style into the evening as lives get busier and the autumn days get shorter. Two-thirds of the Arboretum will be on display, each garden offering varying lighting techniques. From experiments with color and light temperatures to those playing with motion and light—each is designed to expand the appreciation and imagination of a nighttime garden. John Garner and his highly trained staff from Southern Lights of Raleigh will be on site to answer any questions.

This is a family-friendly event. "Children love being in the garden; they respond well to beauty and appreciate and enjoy something that looks and feels magical," said Weathington. "Anything you do that gets children out and looking at plants, gardens, and natural areas is important. It's a powerful way to instill an appreciation for the environment around them."
